**Natural Ornaments**



## Twig Reindeer Ornaments

### Supplies:

- straight branches (1 per ornament)
- v-branches (2 per ornament)
- smaller branches for head & antlers
- Naturally Wired florist wire
- wire cutters
- pruners (for cutting branches)
- scissors
- craft ribbon
- glue gun



### Directions:

1. From branches gathered from the yard, find two v-branches that are close in size. These will serve as the reindeer's legs. The straight branch will serve as the body, while the smaller branches serve as the reindeer head and antlers.
2. Cut branches to the desired length and attach each part together to form the reindeer body using Naturally Wired florist wire.
3. Wire smaller branches together to form the head and antlers; attach to body with Naturally Wired florist wire.
4. Tie a 5-inch piece of craft ribbon around the reindeer's neck. Fold another 5-inch piece of ribbon in half and glue ends together to form a loop for hanging the ornament. Attach loop to ornament with hot glue.



## Pinecone & Nut Cluster Ornaments

### Supplies:

- mixed nuts in shells
- small pinecones
- Styrofoam balls
- hot glue gun
- ribbon
- scissors



### Directions:

1. Hot glue nuts and pinecones to the Styrofoam ball.
2. Cut ribbon into 5-inch lengths; fold a piece of ribbon in half and glue ends together to form a loop for hanging the ornament. Attach loop to ornament with hot glue.



## Pinecone Ornaments

### Supplies:

- large pinecones
- craft ribbon
- glue gun
- scissors

### Directions:

1. Cut ribbon into 5-inch lengths. Fold a piece of ribbon in half and glue ends together to form a loop for hanging the ornament.
2. Attach loop to large pinecone with hot glue.



**Twig Star of David**

**Supplies:**

- six branches
- Naturally Wired florist wire
- pruners
- wire cutters



**Directions:**

1. Cut branches so that they are equal in size. The longer they are, the larger the star will be.
2. Arrange two groups of three branches into triangles and secure ends with Naturally Wired florist wire.
3. Place one twig triangle on a flat surface, then place the second one in the opposite direction, so that together they form the shape of a Star of David. Secure with Naturally Wired florist wire.
4. Attach Twig Star of David to the treetop using a piece of Naturally Wired florist wire.
